



ARTIST INFORMATION & STUDIO APPLICATION

Due to the nature of this historic building and its infrastructure, studios are not suited to performing artists nor for all visual art disciplines. For example, large scale art work (sculpture, painting, carving, etc.) and certain disciplines (metal forging, welding, print making, stone carving, kiln work) will not be accepted. Any work that requires heavy equipment, bulky materials or a loading dock is not viable. In addition to visual artists, we do encourage graphic artists, writers, poets, film, photography, and architects to apply.

Selected artists will need to demonstrate their ability to meet the financial obligations conveyed with the lease terms. Studios will be leased as space is available and pending suitability of artistic practice. Lease terms and renewal options are negotiable.

In addition to meeting the requirements of the application process, selected applicants will be subject to a credit background check.
